What is this form?



It is a consent form.

This means it lets Aruma staff know if you say yes or no to some types of help.



It is not for saying yes or no to sharing information about you.



Skip any questions that the staff do not need to ask you.





How do I use this form?



Someone from Aruma must show you the form.

They will explain it to you and help you fill it out.



Tick the yes box if you say yes to something.



Tick the no box if you say no to something.
